



2010 Official WPTAPL™ Point Award Guidelines

The WPTAPL™ 2010 Point Award Guidelines awards points to the top 16 finishers in all events. There are 1,500 base points with a percentage of those points being awarded based on finishing position. In addition there are **Attendance Bonus Points** for events with 33 players or more. The **Attendance Bonus** is calculated by multiplying the number of entrants by 10. Total points awarded are based on your percentage of the base points (based on finishing position) and your percentage of the bonus points (if available). The tables, and examples below show how your points are calculated.

Example 1: John finishes 4th in a 32 player event.

4th place receives 8% of the base points available (1,500)
 $1,500 \times 8\% = 120$

Bonus points:

There are no bonus points as the event was less than 33 players.

Johns total points for this event are **120**

Example 2: John finishes 4th in a 64 player event.

4th place receives 8% of the base points available (1,500)
 $1,500 \times 8\% = 120$

Bonus points:

64 multiplied by 10 = 640

4th place receives 8% of the bonus points available $640 \times 8\% = 51.2$

Johns total points for this event are $120 + 51.2 = 171.2$
